**Illustration:** If a Citi Rewards Credit Card with 100 reward points is upgraded to Citi PremierMiles Credit Card, then 78% of 100 reward points, i.e. 78 miles will be credited in Citi PremierMiles Credit Card. Similarly if the same Citi Rewards Credit Card is swapped to IndianOil Citi Credit Card, then 35% of 100 reward points, i.e 35 turbo points will be credited in the swapped IndianOil Citi Credit Card.
